

## **A Brief Introduction to Mr. Sun**

Shulin Sun (*Chuan Shi* as his pen name), is a first-class artist. He was once a student of Mr. Keran Li, the Master of Chinese Traditional Painting in the history of China.

Mr. Sun started learning drawing from his childhood. He graduated from the Art Department of Beijing Normal University majoring in Traditional Chinese painting. He once held the post of director of Chinese Calligraphy and Painting Research Association and the minister of Art Displaying Department. With the invitations from the University of Luxembourg of Federal Republic of Germany and Houston of Texas of the United States, he successfully held his individual art exhibitions in these two countries. On numerous occasions, Sun also attended the Chinese outstanding artists' galleries conducted by Taiwan, Japan and Singapore, etc. and received the golden prizes in domestic and international art competitions as well. In 1995, one of his best art pieces named "Late autumn" --- was selected into the Contemporary Collections of Chinese Famous Artists' Calligraphy and Paintings.

In 2002 & 2004, he held the post of the director of Evaluation Committees for

the First Michigan Chinese Youth Art Competition and the US National Youth Art Competition respectively. Currently, in his spare time, he continues to paint in creative methods and teach youth and adult art lessons.
